

Terms and Conditions – MathWorks Robot Competition (France, 2016)

These Terms and Conditions govern your participation at The MathWorks SAS (“MathWorks”) “Mission On Mars Robot Challenge” to take place in France in 2016.

Participation and Conditions of Entry:

How to Enter :

- A representative from each team should register on MathWorks website, mentioning the name, the age and contact details of each participant.
- Minimum 2 people and maximum 4 people per team.
- Each team member must be 15 year old or more.
- A pre-qualifying phase will be held (via email) to select the finalist teams participating in the competition at Innorobo show on May 25th 2016, in Paris.
- Participation is free (MathWorks is not paying for travel and accommodation).

Judging :

- The competition will be held between May 24th & May 26th, 2016, during Innorobo show in Paris.
- The competition will be judged by MathWorks engineers. An automated system will make the decision based on the time spent to complete the course. There will be qualifying heats and a final. The winning team will be the one that will succeed in the fastest time during the final.
- Full instructions and judging criteria will be supplied during the preparation phase of the competition and on the day of the event.
- Prizes will be awarded for the first, second and third place teams.
- Winners must be in attendance at the event to collect their prize. In the event that the winning team is not in attendance, first place will be awarded to the second placed team. There is no cash alternative.
- The name of the top three winning teams will be announced on the MathWorks website, MakerZone website, Innorobo website, and MathWorks social properties such as Facebook, Twitter, Youtube and LinkedIn.
- Decisions by the judges are final.
